## **REDWOOD CELEBRATES 41,000 SQUARE FEET OF PROMISE AND POTENTIAL!**

(Ft. Mitchell, KY)- Redwood Rehabilitation Center will dedicate their newly expanded facility at a Ribbon Cutting Ceremony on Tuesday, November 15, 2005.

This dedication marks the end of the first facility expansion in over 25 years. Duke Realty Corporation donated construction management services for the \$6.3 million dollar project, which doubled the building size from 41,000 square feet to 82,000 square feet.

Redwood, a United Way agency in Northern Kentucky, serves over 600 children and adults with multiple and severe disabilities each year through educational, vocational and therapeutic programs. The expansion will allow Redwood to eliminate the waiting list of children and adults in need of services. It will also give the agency plenty of room to grow for future needs.

“We are truly grateful to individuals, corporations, and foundations for their commitment and understanding of our need to expand and renovate to ensure a brighter, better future for people facing life’s greatest challenges,” stated Barbara Howard, Executive Director.

Included on the agenda for the Ribbon Cutting Ceremony will be the placement of a time capsule in a pillar of the Luther Foundation Welcome Center. The time capsule will include various memorabilia from parents, staff and board members, and will be reopened on Redwood’s 100th anniversary in May 2053.
