Re: Covid Procedure Change

Redwood Employees and Families,

I want to begin by thanking everyone who has worked so hard to keep Redwood safe the past several months. Recent data is showing that the COVID-19 positivity rates are significantly lower across Northern Kentucky. As a result, Redwood will be making some changes to our COVID-19 procedures.

Masking:

Effective immediately, masks are only required in program rooms. This includes childcare, therapy, and adult programs. Masks will no longer be required to enter the building.

- Anyone entering a classroom or any other area where clients are present, must be masked. This includes employees, visitors, and families.
- Please do not enter the building if you are experiencing any COVID symptoms.

COVID Vaccines and Boosters:

No changes to this policy. We strongly recommend that everyone get vaccinated and boosted when eligible. A second booster shot has recently been approved by the CDC, specifically for those who are high risk. Below is a link to the Northern Kentucky Health Department with more detailed information.
